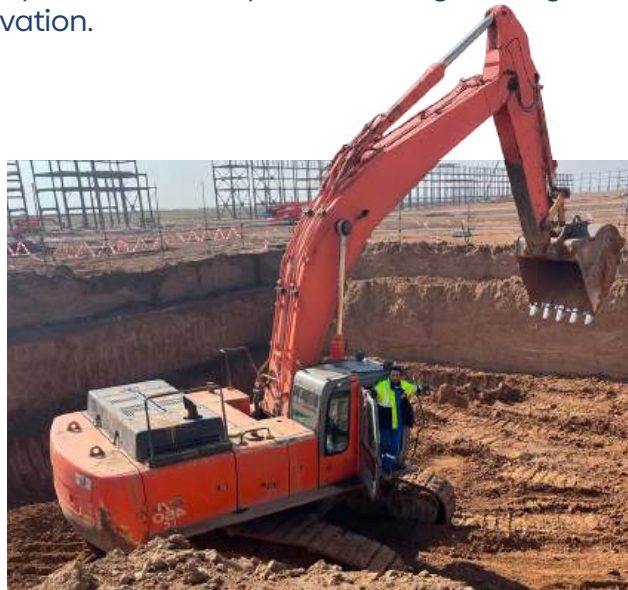

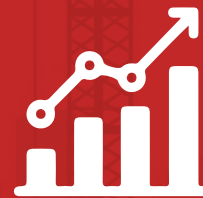

Rehabilitation of the Railway Bridge in Baiji District, Salah Al-Din Governorate, Iraq

Project Description

Al-Khattab Al-Muttahida for Contracting, General Trading and Real Estate Investments Ltd. was awarded a contract by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) to carry out the Rehabilitation of the Railway Bridge in Baiji District, Salah Al-Din Governorate, Iraq.

Scope of Work

1. Site preparation and traffic management.
2. Reinforced concrete works, including foundations, abutments, piers, bridge deck, and transition slabs.
3. Supply and installation of precast prestressed concrete bridge girders and bearing pads.
4. Backfilling works and paving of bridge approaches and bridge deck.
5. Supply and installation of bridge expansion joints.
6. Road marking and pedestrian crossing painting.
7. Plumbing and sanitary works.
8. Supply and installation of galvanized steel guardrails.
9. Supply and installation of solar-powered LED lighting poles.

Reconstruction of the Badoush Steel Bridge, Nineveh Governorate, Iraq

Project Description

Al-Khattab Al-Muttahida for Contracting, General Trading and Real Estate Investments Ltd. signed a contract with the Reconstruction Fund for Areas Affected by Terroristic Operations (REFAATO) for the Reconstruction of the Badoush Steel Bridge in Tel Kaif District, Nineveh Governorate. The bridge had sustained severe damage as a result of terrorist attacks, causing the collapse of five (5) spans and extensive damage to various structural components. The company successfully completed the project in accordance with the contract requirements and the Bill of Quantities (BOQ).

Scope of Work

1. Supply of divers, hydraulic jacks, pontoons, equipment, and machinery for lifting and removing the remains of the old bridge, together with cleaning the project site and a 50 m-wide section of the river on both sides.
2. Accurate determination of the lengths of the new bridge spans and the corresponding installation levels.
3. Lifting and reconstruction of the destroyed pier supporting the right carriageway, rehabilitation of the opposite pier, supply

of steel pipes with the same original diameter, thickness, and specifications, supply and installation of equivalent reinforcing steel, placement of C30 reinforced concrete, execution of anchoring, welding, and connection works, strengthening of the damaged column, and application of anti-corrosion coating followed by two coats of oil-based paint to all exposed steel components.

4. Removal of the existing steel pier caps and installation of new steel caps with identical specifications, removal of the existing stiffeners and bracing members connecting the piers, and installation and welding of new steel stiffeners and bracing members with the same specifications.
5. Supply and installation of a complete Bailey Bridge steel structure with a total length of 210 m, a width of 5 m, and a 50-ton load capacity, consisting of five (5) spans, each 42 m long, including a 1 m-wide pedestrian walkway and launching rollers.
6. Milling and paving of the bridge approaches over a width of 10 m on both sides, including the construction of a 150 mm Base Course, a 100 mm Asphalt Binder Course, and a 50 mm Asphalt Wearing

Course, together with the application of Prime Coat over the Base Course and Tack Coat between the asphalt layers.

7. Construction of 10 m-long steel safety fences at both the entrance and exit of the bridge on both sides.
8. Installation and testing of galvanized lighting poles, including the installation of 250 W lighting fixtures with photocells, together with the installation of high-quality electrical cables of suitable sizes.

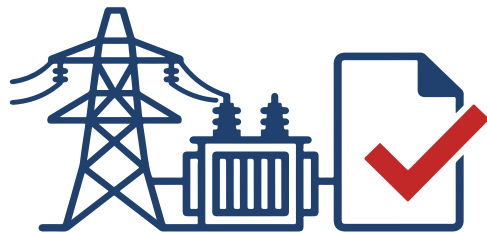

In 2015, Al-Khattab Al-Muttahida for Contracting, General Trading and Real Estate Investments Ltd. signed a contract with the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) for the supply of pumping units, borehole submersible pumps, and river submersible pumps to Zummar, Nineveh Governorate.

The company contracted with specialized manufacturers to produce the required pumps, which were subsequently shipped to the warehouses of the Nineveh Water Directorate in Zummar. Following the handover of the project site, work commenced and was completed with a 100% completion rate.

Maintenance, Rehabilitation, Asphalt Paving, and Road Marking of the Qayyarah Bridge – Al-Mahwar Checkpoint Road (7.5 m Width)

Project Description:

A contract was awarded by the Nineveh Governorate – Contracts Department for the execution of this project under the IQD 135 billion allocation for migration and displaced persons projects in Nineveh Governorate. Al-Khattab Al-Muttahida for Contracting, General Trading and Real Estate Investments Ltd. carried out the project by providing a comprehensive range of civil works and services in accordance with the contract requirements and the Bill of Quantities (BOQ).

Scope of Work:

1. Construction of single pipe culverts with a 1.0 m diameter, encased in reinforced concrete, including backfilling of the approaches using Class A crushed aggregate placed in 200 mm layers, with watering and compaction, while maintaining the required side slopes at the culvert inlets and outlets.

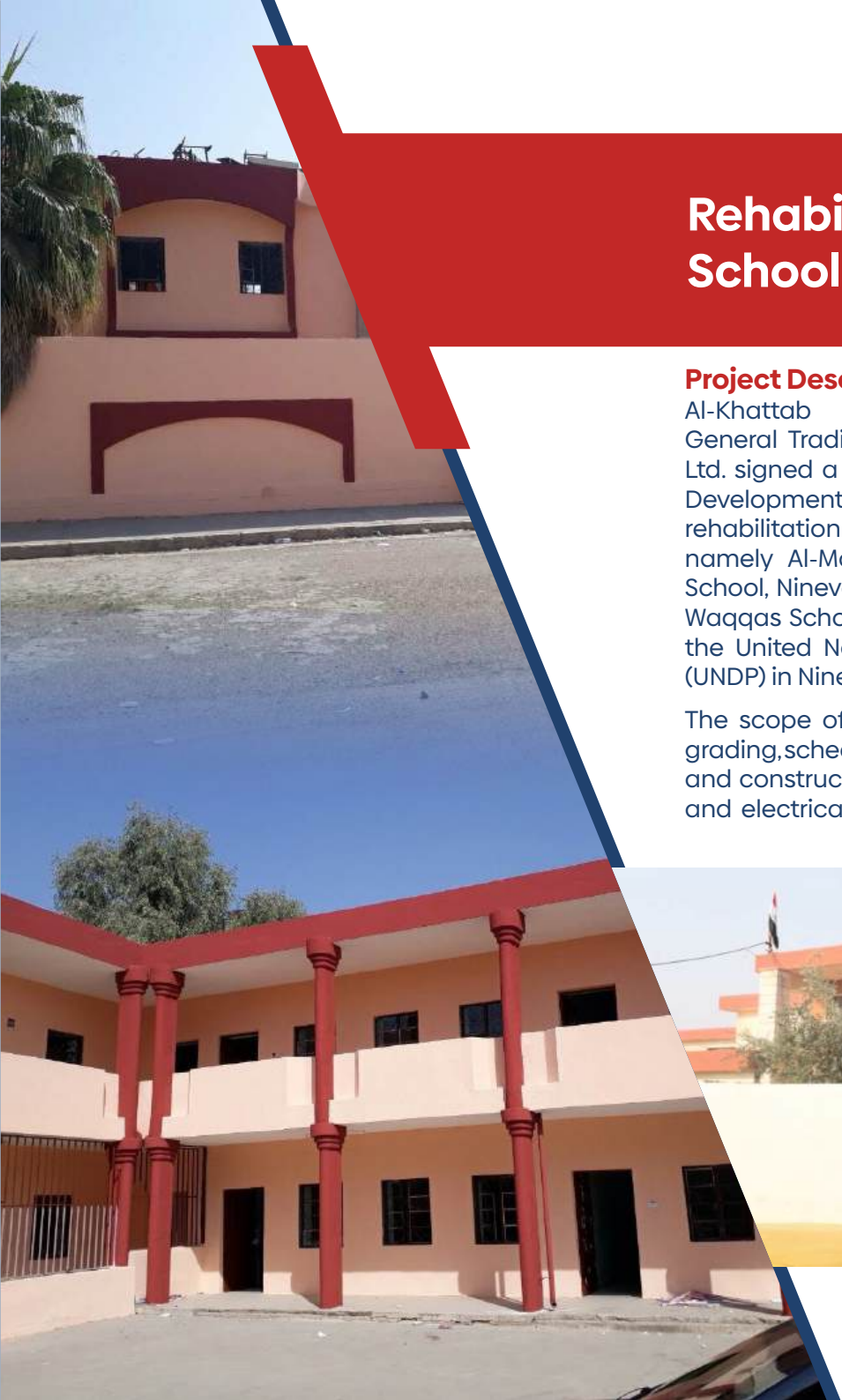
